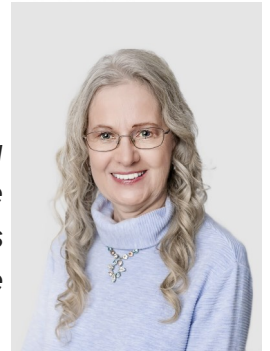

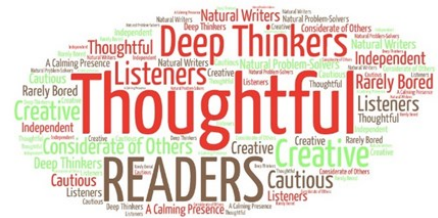
How does one lead to inspire others to demonstrate **thoughtfulness**?

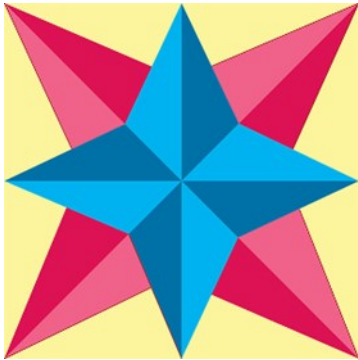
Leadership
