#### 1. LEADERSHIP:


Set the roadmap for your goals. Submit a Club Strategic Plan to the District Governor.

## ASTRA GRANTS ARE AVAILABLE


District Three would like to remind all Clubs that sponsor an ASTRA Club, that KM ASTRA Grant Funds for District Three ASTRA Clubs are available!
