From Dimples' Kitchen to Yours.

Classic Shortbread

1 cup butter, softened (land O'Lakes; do not substitute)

1/8 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/8 teaspoon salt

½ cup sugar

2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour

Sugar to garnish

Beat butter at medium speed of electric mixer until creamy; gradually add the ½ cup sugar, beating well. Stir in vanilla. Combine flour and salt; gradually add to butter mixture, beating at low speed after each addition. Roll dough to ½ inch thickness on lightly floured surface. Cut with preferred shape cookie cutters. Place 1-2 inches apart on ungreased baking sheets. Sprinkle with additional sugar. Bake at 275 degrees for 45 minutes. Remove to wire rake and cool completely. Yield: 1-2 dozen depending on size of cookie cutter used.
